

# **Blood on the Dance Floor**

### ILBIJERRI Theatre Company & Jacob Boehme, Australia

We hold memories in our blood. It connects us. It defines us.

Following a sell-out premiere season, *Blood on the Dance Floor* explores the legacies and memories embedded in our bloodlines. Examining the ways in which blood defines a person, **Jacob Boehme** questions how our most precious life source can both unite and divide us in our quest for community and connection.

Boehme is a choreographer, dancer and writer from the Narangga and Kaurna nations of South Australia. When Jacob was diagnosed with HIV in 1998 he reached out to his ancestors in search of answers.

Blood on the Dance Floor is a passionate and unapologetic physical monologue told in a contemporary voice. It pays homage to the ceremonies of Boehme's ancestors, whilst dissecting the politics of being gay, Blak and HIV Positive.

Blood on the Dance Floor is produced by the award-winning **ILBIJERRI Theatre Company**, Australia's leading and longest-running Indigenous theatre company. ILBIJERRI create, present and tour challenging and provocative theatrical works that describe with empathy and honesty the experiences of Indigenous people in Australia today. Their work empowers and enlightens audiences, urges discussion and brings Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander voices into the foreground of the national conversation.

Jacob Boehme is a Melbourne-based multidisciplinary theatre maker. He trained in dance at NAISDA and is an alumnus of the Victorian College of the Arts, graduating with a Master of Writing for Performance (2014), and Master of Puppetry (2007). He is also an alumnus of the British Council's ACCELERATE Indigenous Leadership Program and has recently been appointed Creative Director of the Melbourne Indigenous Arts Festival. *Blood on the Dance Floor* is Jacob's debut as a playwright, first developed as part of ILBIJERRI's Black Writers Lab.
