## Huff AUSTRALIAN PREMIERE Native Earth Performing Arts, Canada

Sydney Festival presents the Australian premiere of the critically acclaimed one-man show, *Huff* from **Native Earth Performing Arts**, Canada's oldest professional Indigenous theatre company. As *Huff* opens, a boy named Wind is trying to end his life. It is, he thinks, his only escape from a vicious cycle of abuse, neglect, violence and solvent-sniffing.

Huff is the wrenching, yet darkly comic tale of Indigenous brothers caught in a torrent of solvent abuse and struggling to cope with the death of their mother. Wind's fantastic dream world bleeds into his haunting reality, as he's preyed on by the Trickster through the hallways at school, the abandoned motel he loves more than home, and his own fragile psyche.

Award-winning Indigenous performer and playwright **Cliff Cardinal** deftly portrays over a dozen characters in his unflinching, dream-like portrayal combining mythic storytelling with the harsh realities of life on a First Nations reserve in Northern Ontario. Sobering, but with a heavy dose of black humor, *Huff* takes a hard look where so many have turned a blind eye.

Touted as one of the most exciting new voices in Canadian theatre, Cardinal made his theatrical debut with Native Earth in *Freeman's Wake* by **Yvette Nolan** in 2005. His work as a performer has been recognized across Canada, including a Jessie Richardson Memorial Theatre Award nomination for Outstanding Performance for *Tales of an Urban Indian* by **Darrell Dennis** with **Green Thumb Theatre**.

As a playwright, Cardinal's first play *Stitch* premiered to great acclaim, winning both the Spotlight Award for Performance and Theatre Passe Muraille's Emerging Artist Award for Notable Artistic Impression at Toronto's SummerWorks Festival. For *Huff*, he was awarded the 2012 Buddies in Bad Times Vanguard Award for Risk & Innovation and the 2015 RBC Tarragon Emerging Playwright Prize. Cliff won the 2016 Dora Mavor Moore Awards for Outstanding New Play and Outstanding Performance for this production of *Huff*.

Native Earth Performing Arts, currently in its 34th year, is dedicated to creating, developing and producing professional artistic expressions of the Indigenous experience in Canada.
