With raw athletic power and explosive, urban-infused dance, six performers push themselves to their limits as they pull apart the roles of inheritor and predecessor against a backdrop of stunning animations and within an atmospheric, electric soundscape.

Inheritor Album is visually stunning, emotionally moving and intellectually stimulating. It explores interpretations of inheritance and succession by looking at a transitional period between the two, creating brief snapshots of one generation’s place in time. *Inheritor Album* is a meditation on change that calls for simultaneous strength and surrender, with the dance embodying this duality.

The work is made up of a series of short pieces that read like the tracks of an album and features sound design by **Kristen Roos** and integrated projected film/animation elements by visual artist **Miwa Matreyek**. Part of the stage work was adapted for director **Brian Johnson**’s award-winning short film, *Inheritor Recordings*.

Inheritor Album showcases **605 Collective**’s unique and collaborative movement derived from house, hip-hop, capoeira and contemporary dance practices and is a lightning quick, hugely physical, viscerally exciting and powerful performance.

Vancouver’s Company 605 continues to push into new territories to awaken a fresh and exciting aesthetic inspired by the exchange between urban and contemporary dance. Their athletic, fast-paced and playful work has attracted hip-hop fans, families with children, classical dance lovers and the wider contemporary arts community.
