Institute, from UK physical theatre company **Gecko**, is an astonishing performance combining witty choreography, artful imagery and ingenious stagecraft. Through spellbinding movement, the work examines the role of care in our society, with a particular focus on mental health.

Creator and Artistic Director, **Amit Lahav**, asked the company: "What does it mean to care for one another in a busy world of high-pressure targets and expectations; to lose everything and everyone? Where do you turn?"

Set in a mysterious place of dark shadows and towering filing cabinets that gradually reveal their secrets over the course of the show, performers collide in an extraordinary world of movement and exquisite storytelling. Martin longs for one more breath with Margaret. Daniel climbs higher and higher over a towering world but will he fulfil his ambition? Stuck in this beguiling maze of officialdom they lurch from one outrageous task to another. But who is giving the orders?

Their state of mind is reflected in an atmospheric set design and a powerful soundtrack by longstanding collaborator **Dave Price**. Set within a Kafkaesque puzzle that's bewildering and beautiful, *Institute* is filled with theatrical surprises and transformations that will make audiences laugh and gasp in equal measure.

Formed in 2001, Gecko is an award-winning and internationally-acclaimed physical theatre company who create visual, visceral and ambitious theatre. Gecko strives to make its work open to interpretation and put audiences at the heart of the narrative.
