




## Alice in Wonderland is on at Riverside Theatres in Parramatta. There are signs out the front saying "Riverside"




## There are sliding doors going into the foyer

There will be a different usher inside to see where you will be sitting.




The usher will show you to your seat.

The performer will begin to tell you a story.


They will use words, acting, movement and some puppets!

## ALICE IN Wonderland


When the show is finished, people will clap their hands to say thank you to the performers.
