Made up of the Carabinier-Lépine family and friends, Cirque Alfonse gets its name from Saint-Alphonse-Rodriguez, its municipality of origin in Lanaudière. Québec is central to each Cirque Alfonse creation, and the troupe draws on national folklore for its themes, with a modern touch.

The Alfonse clan captured the hearts of the public in 2011 with lumber camp creation, *Timber!*, and its electro-traditional cabaret *Barbu* in 2014, followed by *Tabarnak* in 2017. After touring the globe several times to world-wide success, the troupe returns to Australia to bring you an unforgettable time.
