LUKE DI SOMMA

Melbourne-based Luke Di Somma is an award-winning composer, lyricist and musical director working in musical theatre, opera and television. Originally from Aotearoa NZ, he is a Fulbright scholar, having studied at the Tisch School at New York University. He is the co-creator and songwriter for *Happiness* – a new musical TV comedy coming to screens in 2025. Last year he composed and conducted *The Unruly Tourists* for New Zealand Opera, and he is the co-writer of hit Kiwi musical *That Bloody Woman*. His debut album *Songs For My Friends* was released in 2021, and he has several new works in development.

CONSTANTINE COSTI

Constantine Costi's 2024 highlights included a staging of Schoenberg's *Pierrot Lunaire* (Berliner Philharmoniker), Puccini's *II Tabarro* (Opera Australia), William Bolcom's *Long Lost Loves* (Musica Viva), *II Tabarro* outdoors (Sydney Festival/Victorian Opera) and documentary feature film The Golden Spurtle (Hopscotch Films UK/Hytra Films). 2025 sees Constantine directing a re-imagined version of Mozart's Die Entführung Aus Dem Serail titled Abduction (Victorian Opera). His opera film A Delicate Fire for Pinchgut Opera was awarded Best Australian Feature Film at the Sydney Women's Film Festival and the ATOM Award's Best Experimental Film. For Victoria Opera his direction of Shostakovich's operetta Moscow, Cheremushki as Melbourne Cheremushki earned him a Best Direction Green Room Award. His work explores the possibilities of the operatic form from outdoor spectacles La Traviata on Sydney Harbour (Opera Australia), to Weill's Mahagaonny Songspiel and The Seven Deadly Sins in a pub-theatre for 60 audience members.
